



Membership Categories and Dues Structure 2014-2015

Licensed and Certified Providers

Membership may be available to an entity that is individually licensed by the State of Connecticut as a home health care agency and certified by Medicare as a home health agency and /or hospice. Dues are based on total agency cost or expenditures as reported on one of the following forms of documentation: (1) Worksheet A, Column 6 of your 2013 Medicare Cost report; (2) Worksheet H, Column 6 of your 2013 Medicare Cost report; or (3) 2013 Audited Financial Statement.

Affiliate Providers

Membership may be available to an entity that provides home care services (e.g., licensed homemaker-home health aide agency, homemaker-companion, home infusion, assisted living services agency, etc.) that otherwise does not qualify for membership as a Licensed and Certified Provider. An access agency would qualify as an Affiliate Provider member. Dues are based on annualized gross sales as reported on the most recent available sales tax form (or an applicable substitute) with the following breakpoints:

Annualized Gross Sales	Dues	Special Dues Exceptions
\$0 - 500,000	\$500	If an Affiliate Provider is related to a parent holding company or subsidiary of, or an Affiliate Provider under common ownership or control with, a Licensed and Certified Provider member and the expenses for the Affiliate Provider are not included in the calculation of the dues for the Licensed and Certified Provider, then the member dues are only an additional \$250 for the Affiliate Provider. If the expenses for the Affiliate Provider are included in the above calculation, then there are no additional dues for the Affiliate Provider.

Associates

Membership may be available to an organization or individual whose services relate indirectly to community health and home care, and is not a provider of home care services. Associate membership is divided into four (4) sub-categories:

Organizations have the opportunity to upgrade their membership to the following categories (*see application for more details*):

- **Premier Membership - \$3,000**
Includes: One year HC@H membership, Sponsorship of up to three HC@H educational programs during the year (excluding any annual conferences), Bi-annual electronic copies of HC@H’s member email list, and 6 months of advertising on the homepage of HC@H’s website
- **Exhibition Membership - \$2,000**
Includes: One year HC@H membership, Exhibit booth at HC@H’s Annual Conference in Fall 2014 (inc. 2 registrations), Bi-annual electronic copies of HC@H’s member email list, and 6 months of advertising on the homepage of HC@H’s website
- **Standard Membership - \$1,500**
Includes: One year HC@H membership, Bi-annual electronic copies of HC@H’s member email list, and 6 months of advertising on the homepage of HC@H’s website
